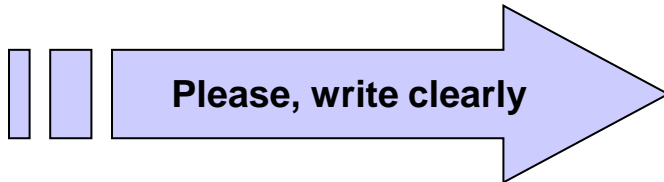

ART – Pascale Hery
