

The exam relates to foreign languages chosen from English, German, Spanish or Italian and to regional languages from Basque, Breton, Catalan, Corsican, Creole, Occitan-langue d'Oc or Tahtrian. The exam can also cover, as an experiment with effect from the start of the 2019 school year, Portuguese, in the education authorities of Guyana, Certeil, Paris and Versailles.

The exam covers the choice of one of the ancient languages and cultures: Latin or Greek.</sup>
